## #12-109 – Tenure Track Assistant Professor Department of Public Management

The Department of Public Management at the University of New Haven invites applicants for a tenure-track assistant professor position in Public Administration/Health Care Administration, to begin in Fall 2013.

***Required qualifications:*** A Ph.D. in Public Administration, Public Policy, or Public Health, with a strong grounding in and ability to teach research methodology. A DPA degree may be considered, if combined with professional experience and an educational background comparable to the Ph.D.

To be considered for this position, successful applicants must be able to articulate a research agenda, have an emerging record of publications, excellent teaching skills, and commitment to service.

***Preferred qualifications:*** Applicants should have an academic and/or professional background in public administration and health care administration or public health. The committee will also consider backgrounds in other areas of health care administration. Publications or professional experiences in either or both desirable areas are definite advantages.

***Responsibilities:*** A person in this position will be teaching (undergraduate and graduate) in the areas of public administration and health care administration or policy, accomplishing research resulting in academic publications, and providing service to the university and community. Courses will be part of a Master of Public Administration, Master of Science in Health Care Administration, Master of Labor Relations, and an undergraduate courses in public administration in service to other programs. Courses are on the main campus of the University of New Haven, in West Haven, Connecticut or in a few off-campus locations within Connecticut. A successful applicant should also have some experience in teaching online classes and using online classroom management systems, such as Blackboard.

2. Curriculum Vitae
3. Letters of recommendation from three professional sources
4. A published journal article or other samples of writing and research (dissertation)
5. Teaching evaluations, if applicable
