Welcome to the School of Health Sciences! For your first semester as a Paramedicine student, our Center for Student Success team will register you for classes based on the results of your placement exams and a brief preregistration survey in your Road Map. (In subsequent semesters, you will register yourself for classes after consultation with an advisor.) While we can't promise that the timing of your courses will be exactly what you want, we will do our best to arrange your classes to fit your schedule.

There are two distinct paths that Paramedicine students could take during their first semester. Each depends on whether or not you have already obtained your Connecticut or National Registry Emergency Medical Technician Certification.

Please Note: If your Emergency Medical Technician Certification is from another state you can apply for **Connecticut Certification**.

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ENGL - English *The exact English course that you will take your first semester is based on your standardized test scores or the results of your English placement exam.
