- > Facilitate collaboration among campus stakeholders including faculty, staff, and student organizations.

### RESULTS

- > Membership renewed with AASHE; UNH members have full access to nationally used tools and resources
- Campus waste survey deployed week of September 16
- > A detailed waste program description with map has been added to the UNH Recycling and Waste Program webpages to inform stakeholders about current programs
- Held the first annual Recycling Drive during UNH's Freshman Move-In Day Event
